Quorum is met – Meeting proceeded

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Eddie Norman at approximately 9:59 a.m.

**2. INVOCATION**

Mayor Pro Tem Eddie offered the invocation.

**3. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

With no one present wishing to speak, the public comments portion of the meeting was closed.

**4. NEW BUSINESS**

Mayor Pro Tem Eddie Norman addressed the Town Commissioners on the structure of the Town Board moving forward with advisement from Town Attorney Ben Harding. Mayor Pro Tem opened the floor for any nominations relating to the board structure.

Commissioner Monta Davis-Oliver nominated Mayor Pro Tem Thomas Eddie Norman, Jr. to fill the position of Mayor for the Town of Yadkinville and to serve out for the term provided by law. Commissioner Betty Driver seconded the motion and passed unanimously.

Ayes 4/0

Commissioner Tony Hall nominated Commissioner Monta Davis-Oliver to fill the position of Mayor Pro Tem. Commissioner Betty Driver seconded the motion and passed unanimously.

Ayes 4/0 – Swearing-in of Mayor Norman took place at the close of the Special Meeting. Therefore, the mayor being present but not having voted is considered to vote Aye on the motion.

Mayor Eddie Norman advised that the Town of Yadkinville currently has two vacant positions on the Town Board of Commissioners. The Board elected to fill one vacant position and defer the second selection at a later date.

Commissioner Tony Hall nominated Scott Winebarger to fill the vacated seat of Kelly Oliver and to serve out for the term provided by law. Commissioner Betty Driver seconded the motion and passed unanimously.

Ayes 4/0 – Swearing-in of Mayor Norman took place at the close of the Special Meeting. Therefore, the mayor being present but not having voted is considered to vote Aye on the motion.

## **5. OLD BUSINESS**

Town Manager provided the Town Board with an updated “Lease of Public Water Distribution Lines and Sewer Lines” agreement with Yadkin County for their review. Mr. Williams explained some of the changes made to the lease. It was the consensus of the Town Board to discuss it at the next regular meeting on April 4, 2016.

Mr. Williams discussed the possibility of having one TDA instead of different Town authorities within Yadkin County. He suggested having one board consisting of town representatives.


Mayor Norman thanked the Town Board for their confidence in him to continue the legacy of the Honorable Mayor Hubert L. Gregory.


## **6. ADJOURNMENT**
