



Annual Meeting Minutes

The annual meeting of the Hinshaw Garden Committee was duly held on Monday, April 18, 2011. The Committee Members met at the Garden at 1:00 p.m. to see what improvements needed to be made for the coming year. They then adjourned to South Street Steak House for the business meeting and lunch.

June Smithdeal made a motion for approval for the 04/20/2010 minutes. Motion was second by Brenda Proctor. All were in favor.

Below are items that were identified by the Committee as needing attention during the coming year:

1. Weeds thru out the Garden needs to be killed.
2. Limbs need to be picked up.
3. Landscaping is needed inside the stonework at the Dogwood Tree on the left side of Garden. It was suggested to use some evergreen ground cover such as Candytuft. Trim dead limbs off the Dogwood Tree and pull weeds (was on last year's to-do list)
4. Chickweed thru out the Garden needs to be killed.
5. Cement bench that is broken – try to fix or replace it (was on last year's to-do list)
6. Dead azalea at the Gazebo needs to be removed
7. There are some stumps located near the storage building that needs to be sawed off level, instead of having the jagged edges sticking up.
8. Garden needs to be remulched.
9. Plant more azaleas around Granddad and remove the thin ones.
10. Use weed and feed on the front half of the garden.

June Smithdeal made a motion for all the above items to be fixed during the coming year. Brenda Proctor seconded the motion. All were in favor.

June Smithdeal welcomed the new committee members; Betty Driver and Barry Bryant.

It was requested that the 2012 meeting be held at 12:30 at the garden then recess to South State Steak House. The committee has requested for Steve Gardner to be at the meeting.


