The Town Board of Commissioners met in a "Special Called" Meeting on Friday, April 22, 2016 to discuss the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Budget.

The purpose of this meeting was to review the 2016-17 Fiscal Year Draft Budget with the recommended changes by the Town Board of Commissioners from the budget workshop held April 8, 2016.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eddie Norman at 12:11 p.m.

2. INVOCATION

Mayor Norman offered the invocation.

3. INVOICE(S) (Attachment #1)

Town Manager Perry Williams presented the Town Board an invoice from Carter & Kirk Paving Co, Inc. of \$41,812 for approval. This invoice presented was for the paving of James, Polk and Cedar Street.

Commissioner Monta Davis-Oliver made a motion to approve the invoice for payment.

Commissioner Tony Hall seconded the motion and passed unanimously.

4. TOWN MANAGER

• **Ethics Training:**

Mr. Williams presented the Board with a September 21st date for the Ethics Training with the Town of Boonville. Several commissioners had conflicts, and it was the consensus of the Board to do the webinar training in-house.

- **Insurance:**

Mr. Williams advised the Town Board on various pricing on health insurance for the Town employees. Mayor Norman and the Board advised that it would be in the best interest of the employees to compare the current insurance with what was quoted by the outside agency.

Town Manger Mr. Williams proposed looking at possible supplemental insurance called the “Ideal Doctor.” It was the consensus of the Board to investigate this benefit further.

- **Vehicle Policy:**

Mr. Williams presented the Board with some possible options for a take-home vehicle policy. He advised that he and Chief Parks had discussed several options. The Board expressed their views and the cost-effectiveness of the policy.

After some discussion, Commissioner Monta Davis-Oliver made a motion that the employees who currently drive Town vehicles be grandfathered in but must remain within Yadkin County limits. Any person(s) hired and authorized to drive a Town vehicle going forward must be within a fifteen-mile radius of the Town Limits.

5. PRESENTATION OF THE 2016-2017 BUDGET (Attachment #2)

Town Manager Perry Williams presented the Board of Commissioners a handout with the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Budget revisions. The Town Board was satisfied with the budget modifications.

The Board of Commissioners recommended the use of Fund Balance of \$117,108 to offset the General Fund Deficit. The Board agreed to the addition of an ABC Zoning Compliance Permit charge of \$75.00 to the Fee Schedule for zoning.

CLOSED SESSION – Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143.318.11 (a)(6); To consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment or conditions of initial employment of an individual;

The Board excused the Town Manager, Town Clerk, Finance Officer and Police Chief from the Closed Session.

Commissioner Monta Davis-Oliver made a motion to go into closed session at 1:12 p.m. under N.C.G.S. 143-318.11 (a)(6) – To consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment or conditions of initial employment of an individual; Commissioner Betty Driver seconded the motion and passed unanimously.


