CALL TO ORDER

2012-2013 BUDGET

Town Manger Christopher Ong presented the 2012-2013 recommended budget and reviewed the major pieces of the budget, including the recommendation to keep the property tax rate unchanged, the implementation of a solid waste user fee with the utility bill, and a 10% increase in water and sewer rates.

BOARD REQUESTS OF TOWN MANAGER

The Board requested the Town Manager to look into the following issues and suggestions.

- Town of Yadkinville Community Park Rental Guideline.
- Send a letter to the new owner of Holt Grove Trailer Park reminding them that the mobile homes will have to be removed from property by September 10, 2013.
- Research potential business license.

DUKE ENERY POWER POLE AT NEW JAIL SITE

Mayor Gregory spoke to the Board about a utility power line at the new jail site. Duke Energy requested to move the pole off the new jail site and place on the Yadkinville Police Department property, there will be no cost to the Town. Consensus of the Board was for this.

COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Commissioner Graham:

1. Street light at Lee and Coolidge – still has not been changed out to the sodium light that we pay for. He suggested again that the Police Department needs to check these lights and note which lights have not been changed out to sodium lights and they need to report the lights that are out.


PUBLIC HEARING SET
