The "Adjourned" Town Board meeting from June 7, 2010 was duly held on June 25th at 11:30 a.m.

Motion was made by Commissioner Eddie Norman to adopt the recommended Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Budget with no changes to the 401k Program. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Betty Driver. All approved. (See attachment 1)

July's Meeting will be held on Monday, July 19, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. due to the Town being closed for the July 4th holiday.

The Town Clerk requested approval for any necessary Amendments needed to close out Fiscal Year 2009-2010. The Town Clerk will provide copies of all the Amendments to the Board at the next meeting. Commissioner Hall made the motion to approve the Town Clerk's request. Commissioner Phillip Graham seconded the motion. All were in favor.

At the June 7th Meeting, the Tax Collector was asked to research the advertising fee that could be charged. The legal amount is four dollars. Commissioner Gene Branon made a motion to change the current advertising fee from one dollar to four dollars. Commissioner Driver seconded the motion. All agreed. This will take effect with the upcoming advertising of the 2010 Taxes.

Upon motion of Commissioner Graham, seconded by Commissioner Norman and unanimous approval by the Board, the following invoices were approved for payment:

Commissioner Norman had nothing to report or inquire about.


Commissioner Branon inquired if the quotes have been received on the sidewalk project. Town Manager Joseph Sloop said he would try and have the quotes by July's meeting.
