A special "Called" meeting* of the Town Board of Commissioners was held on Friday morning, July 22, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and consider the position of an interim town manager until such time as the manager's position can be filled.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gregory and invocation was offered by Commissioner Graham.

Mayor Gregory advised the Board that in the absence of a town manager for the time being, someone needed to be designated to sign checks in case the Mayor or the Town Clerk should not be available. It was the consensus of the Board that Commissioner Graham be authorized to take on this task until the manager's position has been filled.


Joseph was instructed to proceed with advertising the manager's position in the Southern City League of Municipalities News Letter, the monthly League Letter, Monster and/or Career.com. stating the credentials the Board is looking for.

Per instruction of the Board, Joseph has been in contact with Charles Mashburn regarding the possibility of his filling in on a temporary basis as interim manager until the position can be filled permanently. After some discussion, the Board was in agreement for Joseph to contact Mr. Mashburn with an offer of \$45/hour for a 24-hour work week, or as needed, effective August 1, 2011. If this is agreeable with Mr. Mashburn, a contract stating terms and price will be executed.

Mayor Gregory informed the Board that easements for the widening of East Main Street (Old US 421) have been prepared by the attorney. It was the consensus of the Board that the Town proceed with getting the easements signed by the property owners even though the project may be put on hold for a while.

Nothing further claiming the attention of the Board, motion was made by Commissioner Norman that the meeting be adjourned. Commissioner Branon seconded the motion and approval was unanimous.
