HOUSEHOLD TRASH AND RECYCLING

Please observe the following guidelines for regular trash and recycling services:

- Please have your trash and recyclables at the edge of the pavement the night before your scheduled date of pick up.
- Place all recyclable materials in the 64-gallon bin that is provided for you.
- The 96-gallon trash cart is for bagged household trash only. Do not mix construction debris or hazardous materials with your household trash.
- Recycling and garbage are collected on the same day.
- The garbage and recycling containers provided are to remain on the property if you should move.
- Set each can away from each other & any other obstacles (trash can, recycling bin, mailbox, utility pole, etc.) by 3 inches.
- Face the lip on the front of the trash/recycling containers to the road. This will ensure closure of the lids.
- The Town of Yadkinville contracts with GDS-Republic Services for both trash and recycling services.
- There is a \$10 extra charge per month per extra trash/recycling container over one trash and one recycling bin.

Trash and recyclables are collected on the following days:

TRASH (Every week):

- MONDAY East side of Highway 601
- TUESDAY West side of Highway 601

RECYCLING (Every other week beginning October 1, 2020):

- MONDAY East side of Highway 601
- TUESDAY West side of Highway 601

The Garbage and Recycling Bins are to be taken back to your house/business on the same day as pick up by 7 p.m. unless otherwise told by Town Hall.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR RECYCLING:

- Aluminum food and beverage containers:
 - Aluminum soda cans and beer cans, cat food cans, etc.
- Ferrous Cans:
 - > Soup, coffee cans, etc.
- P.E.T. plastic containers with the symbol #1 no microwave trays.
- H.D.P.E. natural plastic containers with the symbol #2:
 - Milk and water jugs, containers only (narrow neck containers)
- H.D.P.E. pigmented plastic containers with symbol #2:
 - Detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles without caps (narrow neck containers); butter and margarine tubs
- Polypropylene plastic food and beverage containers symbol #5 yogurt containers
- Mixed Paper (54), as defined in the most recent ISRI Scrap Specifications Circular (http://www.scrap2.org/specs/16/)
- Sorted Residential Paper and News (56), as defined in the most recent ISRI Scrap Specifications Circular (http://www.scrap2.org/specs/16/)
- Kraft Paper Bags
- Old Corrugated Containers (OCC) no wax coated
- Magazines (OMG):
 - Coated Magazines, catalogues and similar printed materials, junk mail, and soft cover books.
- Aseptic Cartons:
 - Juice boxes, gable top milk and juice containers, soy milk and soap cartons.
- Glass food and beverage containers:
 - Flint (clear), Amber (brown), and Emerald (green)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR RECYCLING:

- Yard Waste
- Styrofoam
- Pizza Boxes (unless free of any food or grease residue)
- Food
- Any liquids
- Diapers
- Clothing/textiles
- Plastic bags or bagged material (newsprint may be placed in a Kraft bag)
- Plastic containers with #3, #4, #5 or #7 on them or no # at all
- Mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics
- Oil or antifreeze containers
- Coat hangers
- Paint cans
- Medical Waste/Sharps
- Any Acceptable Material is no longer acceptable due to its coming into contact with or being contaminated by Unacceptable Material

BULK ITEM PICK UP SERVICES

The Town of Yadkinville will pick up any large or bulky items on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of every month. Citizens must call Town Hall at (336) 679-8732 to schedule a bulk trash pickup by the Tuesday before each Wednesday pick up. Calls made the day of pick up will be scheduled for the following pick up date.

Please observe the following guidelines for bulk item pick up:


- Bulk trash includes household items such as furniture, mattresses, rolled carpet, metals, fencing, flooring, plaster, gypsum, lumber, siding, and appliances that are too large to fit into your rollout container.
- The Town of Yadkinville will pick up televisions but there is a \$10.00 charge that must be paid before we pick up the television. Computer screens are a \$6.00 charge.
- Do not put bulk trash out until the night prior to the pickup.
- All loose scraps need to be in bundles of not more than fifty pounds. Each bundle is considered to be one item. Items that need to be bundled: carpet, metals, fencing, flooring, plaster, gypsum, lumber, and siding.
- Trash must be separated by content (metals/other trash).
- The town will collect up to five (5) bulk trash items per household. There will be a \$7 charge for every item over the limit, which will be billed to the customer. Failure to pay this bill will result in the Town no longer providing the service to that customer.
- Tires, batteries, building materials (brick, block, mortar, cement, concrete, gunite, insulation, shakes, shingles, sticks, or stones), closed containers (such as oil drums), liquids, chemicals, hazardous wastes, logs, and stumps <u>WILL NOT</u> be picked up.
- Bulk trash <u>WILL NOT</u> be collected from businesses and institutions.

LIMB PICK UP

The Town of Yadkinville will pick up limbs on the 2nd Wednesday of every month. For citizens who have trees or limbs down due to an unavoidable circumstance, such as weather, limbs will be mulched as time and manpower permit. The Town will not guarantee a time when limbs will be picked up. Call (336) 679-8732 to schedule a pickup. You must call the Tuesday before the scheduled pick up date. Calls made the day of pick up will be scheduled for the following pick up date.

Please observe the following guidelines for limb pick up:

- The limb pile size must be no larger than 8 feet wide by 8 feet long by 6 feet high. (see chipping diagram below).
- The limb diameter can be no larger than 4 inches.
- The Town <u>DOES NOT</u> accept shrubbery or anything with root mass still attached to the limb, which may contact rocks or other objects that might damage the equipment.
- Limb piles must be free of briars, vines, and loose leaves.
- Limbs must be piled neatly on your property near the road with the large diameter end facing the road. (see chipping diagram below).
- Brush created by contracted businesses or brought in from other communities <u>WILL NOT</u> be removed or chopped by the Town.
- Chipping service is for maintenance of resident's properties <u>ONLY</u>. The Town <u>WILL NOT</u> chip limbs from residents clearing the property.
- The Town will provide the service for a first-come-first-service basis. If your limbs are not picked up and the workers have put in 8 hours of chipping, then your limbs will be scheduled for the next months pick up.
- If any of these guidelines are not followed the items will <u>NOT</u> be collected.



The diagram above illustrates the brush chipping guidelines for the Town of Yadkinville customers. Brush piles <u>MUST MEET</u> these measurements as diagrammed above. The larger ends must be toward the street a minimum of 4' (feet) off the edge of the pavement. Please note anything larger than the stated dimensions many not get chipped for the month.

FALL LEAF PICK UP

The Town of Yadkinville picks up leaves on Tuesdays of the following months; October, November, December, and January. Please visit our website at www.yadkinville.org or contact Town Hall at (336) 679-8732 to confirm the dates.

Please observe the following guidelines for leaf pick up:

- Customers must collect leaves in **CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS**.
- Bags are NOT to EXCEED 50 Gallons in size.
- Leave the bags near the edge of the street pavement.
- DO NOT BLOCK hydrants, meters or mailboxes.
- The bag may only contain leaves.
- No need to contact the Town to have leaves picked up.
