Mr. Jim Drum apprised the committee on the expense of having murals within the Town (30 x 15 runs approximately \$4,500.00).

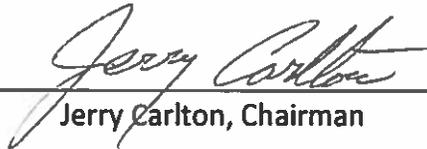
CALENDAR
