The Town Board met in Special Session at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 24. The main purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing on the proposed 2011-2012 budget for the Town of Yadkinville and to take care of any pending business for the current fiscal year, which will end on June 30, 2011.

In the absence of Mayor Gregory, Mayor Pro-Tem Eddie Norman called the meeting to order and asked Commissioner Graham to offer the invocation.

No one was present expressing an opinion or thoughts on the proposed 2011-2012 budget; therefore, upon motion of Commissioner Gene Branon, second by Commissioner Betty Driver and unanimous Board approval, the proposed budget was adopted. (Copy of Budget Ordinance Attached.)

Two invoices were presented for Board approval as follows:

Motion was made by Commissioner Hall that the invoices be approved for payment. Commissioner Graham seconded the motion. All approved.

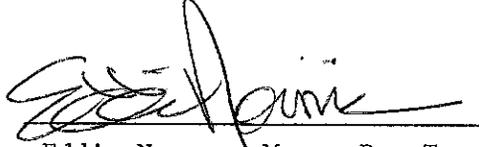
The Manager informed the Board that he was in receipt of correspondence from DOT stating that they were planning to proceed with the re-paving of East Main Street (Old US 421).

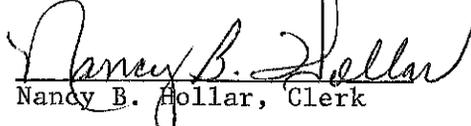
He also reported that he had been in contact with the owner of the El Sarape Restaurant and that they are probably going to appeal the Board's request that they re-paint the outside of their restaurant.

Joseph asked the Board for their input on a revision of the Town's Personnel Policy and Pay Plan. This is a project he is working on in order to update it and bring the pay scales in line with present salaries.

The Clerk asked the Board to approve amendments as necessary to bring the 2010-2011 budget into alignment. Motion was made by Commissioner Norman that the Clerk be authorized to make the necessary amendments to the 2010-2011 budget. Commissioner Driver seconded the motion. Ayes 5 - Noes 0. All matters at hand having been disposed of, Commissioner Branon moved that the meeting be adjourned. Motion seconded by Commissioner Driver. Motion was unanomously approved.
